CROCODILE ROCK

Designed by flamboyant Italian designer Alessandro La Spada, this gigantic three-metre-long, 250-kilogramme hand-blown Murano glass sculpture could soon be on display in Dubai. Created at the world-famous La Murrina atelier furnace in Murano, Italy, ten

artisans spent over 4000 hours creating this magnificent work of art. Originally unveiled during the Salone del Mobile design week in Milan earlier this year, La Murrina has revealed that the life-size crocodile in a fantasy swamp may be shipped to Dubai to make its Middle East debut at the new La Murrina showroom here.
